Stine 9753-20 brand corn is agronomically strong and a top contender for silage acres. It is broadly adaptive across yield environments with southern movement and boasts two modes of action against above-ground pests. It is a tall, robust plant type with lower greensnap risk, and its large root mass and brace roots are good for tougher soils, along with ear flex for moderate planting populations. 9753-20 has a positive response to fungicide in environments with heavy disease pressure and features high yield coupled with test weight.
