This is an excellent choice for all row widths, as it features a medium-tall plant type with medium-tall ear placement, along with very good roots and stalks and stress tolerance. MX551-G excels in high-management acres with an application of sulfur. It also features an industry-leading fungicide and insecticide treatment and yielded a two-year average of 108% in Stine's Early-Mid Elite Trials.
